- Community Development absorbed the Fire Protection District July 1, 2017
- Gary Hames of Battle Born Consulting directed Jessie Fain to use the formulas from the Fire District to
 create an invoice on excel. The invoice increased the plan review and building fee. The plan fees for Fire
 review remained the same. A Community Development employee brought it to Gary Hames and Jessie
 Fain's attention on 8-7-17 that a fee increase cannot take place without the Commissioner's and public
 knowledge/approval and feared Companies would question the increase. Gary stated in front of Jessie Fain
 and Community Development employees, he would plead ignorance if confronted.
- Many tax payers would enjoy the benefit of Elven Thousand Three Hundred and fifty Dollars (\$11,354) per month (in addition to retirement benefits) for a position not qualified for, interviewed for and to plead ignorance in the field. Please investigate payouts made in 2017 to retiring employees. Gary Hames retired June 30th of 2017 and entered into contract July 1st 2017
- The position of Building Official never posted. The Fire Marshall position never posted. Why not?
- Bob Morris stated in email on October 30th 2018 "Storey County has adopted multiple resolutions that update
 the uniform building codes, starting with Resolution No. 03-172, that all use the 1997 construction valuations
 for residential and 1997 building permit fees. Storey County continues to use these same values."
- Was Resolution No. 17-461 ever signed by the Commissioners?
- A thorough investigation with the County Comptroller, current and prior employees may reveal this is just the tip of the iceberg in Storey County, NV. Scratch a lie; find a thief... or a few possibly, if not, no harm no foul.
